Please pay the "Balance Due" on your tuition statement. Please note your child's name on the memo part of your check. We accept checks, money orders, cash or bank auto pay as a form of payment. Also, please be aware that it could possibly take two weeks before your check clears your bank.

We consider it an honor and a privilege to have your children here at Mission Hills Church Preschool. If your family does not have a church home, and you are considering attending Mission Hills Church, our services hours are Sunday at 9:00 am and 11:00 am. Childcare is provided from birth through 5th grade. Middle & High School programs also gather at 9:00 am. In addition, we have a Spanish Ministry that meets at 11:00 am in the High School Venue.
